

USER MANUAL

2. Booking-Mask - 2.6.5. Multiple Prebookings

Provided that the Agent has a valid AWB-Stock assigned, you can create multiple pre-bookings with just a few clicks. You can even send out FFR-messages for all of these prebookings in order to transmit the booking details to the airline-system, if needed.

All you need is to create the very first Prebooking manually as a row model, from which the system will clone the following prebookings from. It simply copies all bookings details and as well as the routing-details, created on other departure-dates of course. To propose the suggested departure dates, the system takes the Departure-date of the 1st routing-leg as the basis.

Step 1:

Enter your row model booking.

Note:

All entered booking details, incl. Dims, OSI, SSR, etc. as well as rates & O/C details will be "copied" into the "cloned" prebookings.

Step 2:

Select an approximate date-period-range in which the pre-bookings shall be flown and also whether there might be more than one booking on the same day.

Also select the week-day/s of the 1st Routing-leg's Departure-day.

Once these selections are taken, the system will then propose you all possible departure-dates in the grid below.
